

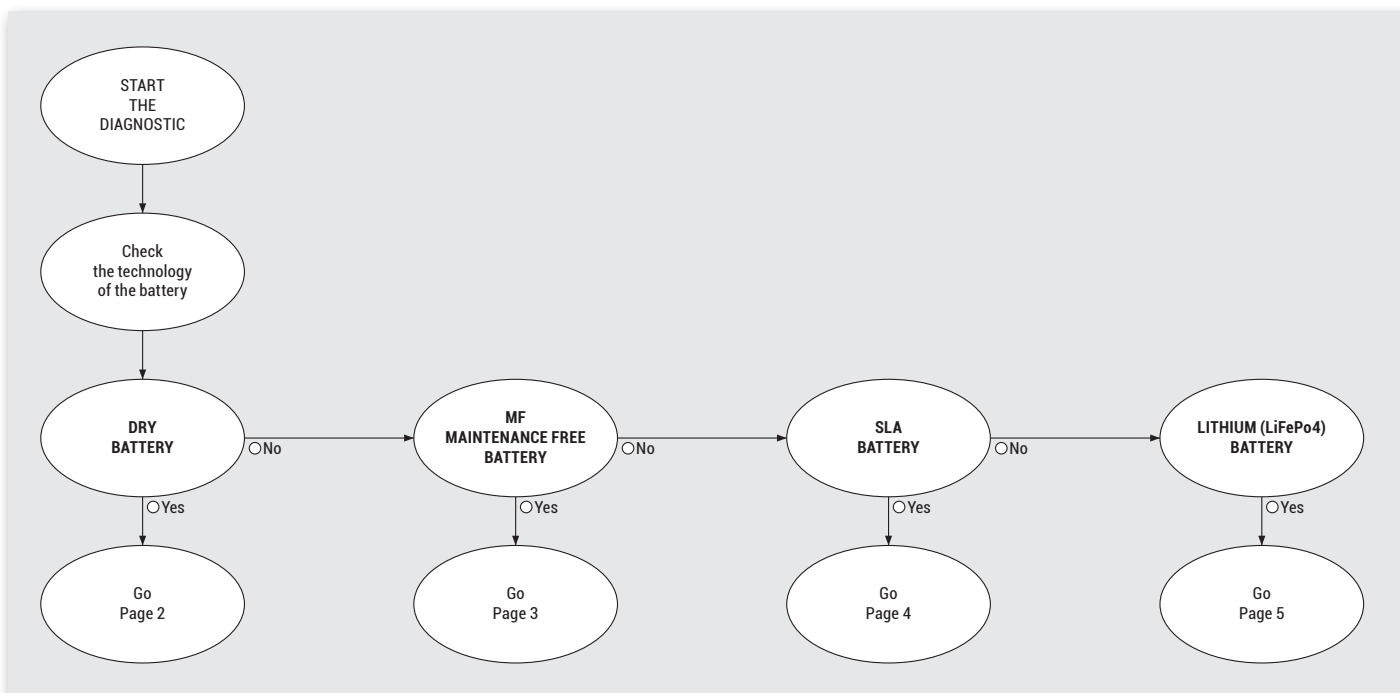

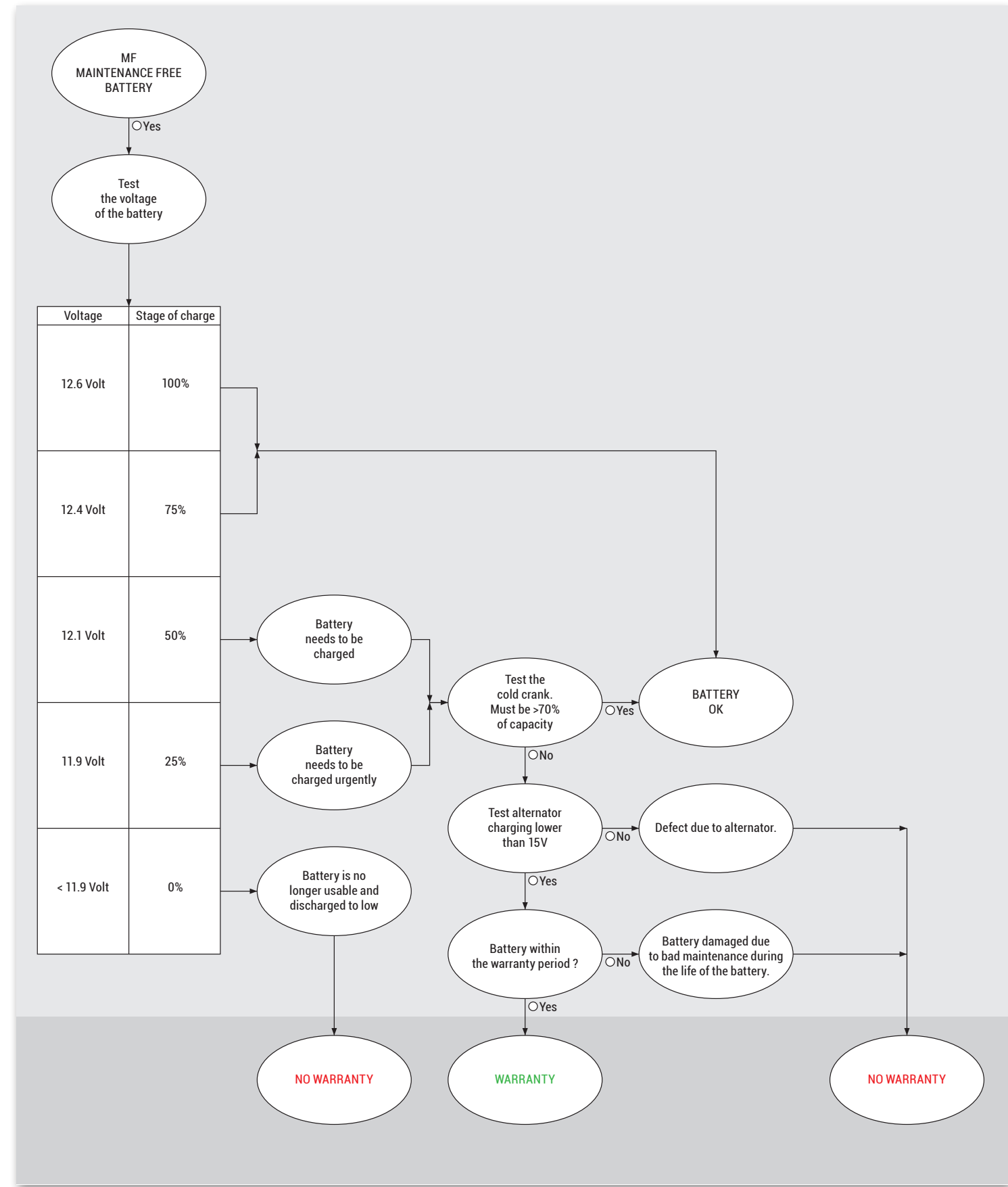
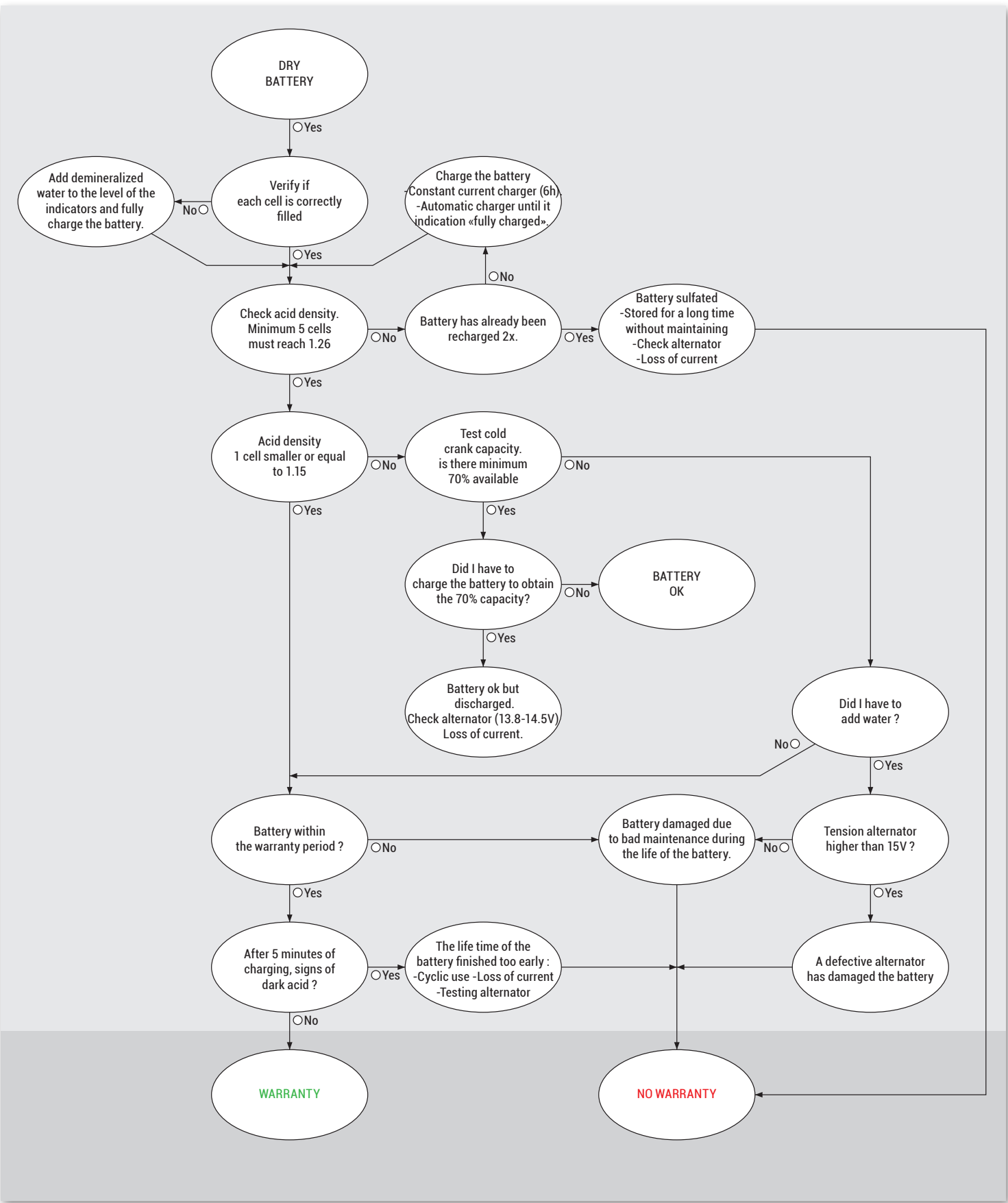
When can we speak of warranty?

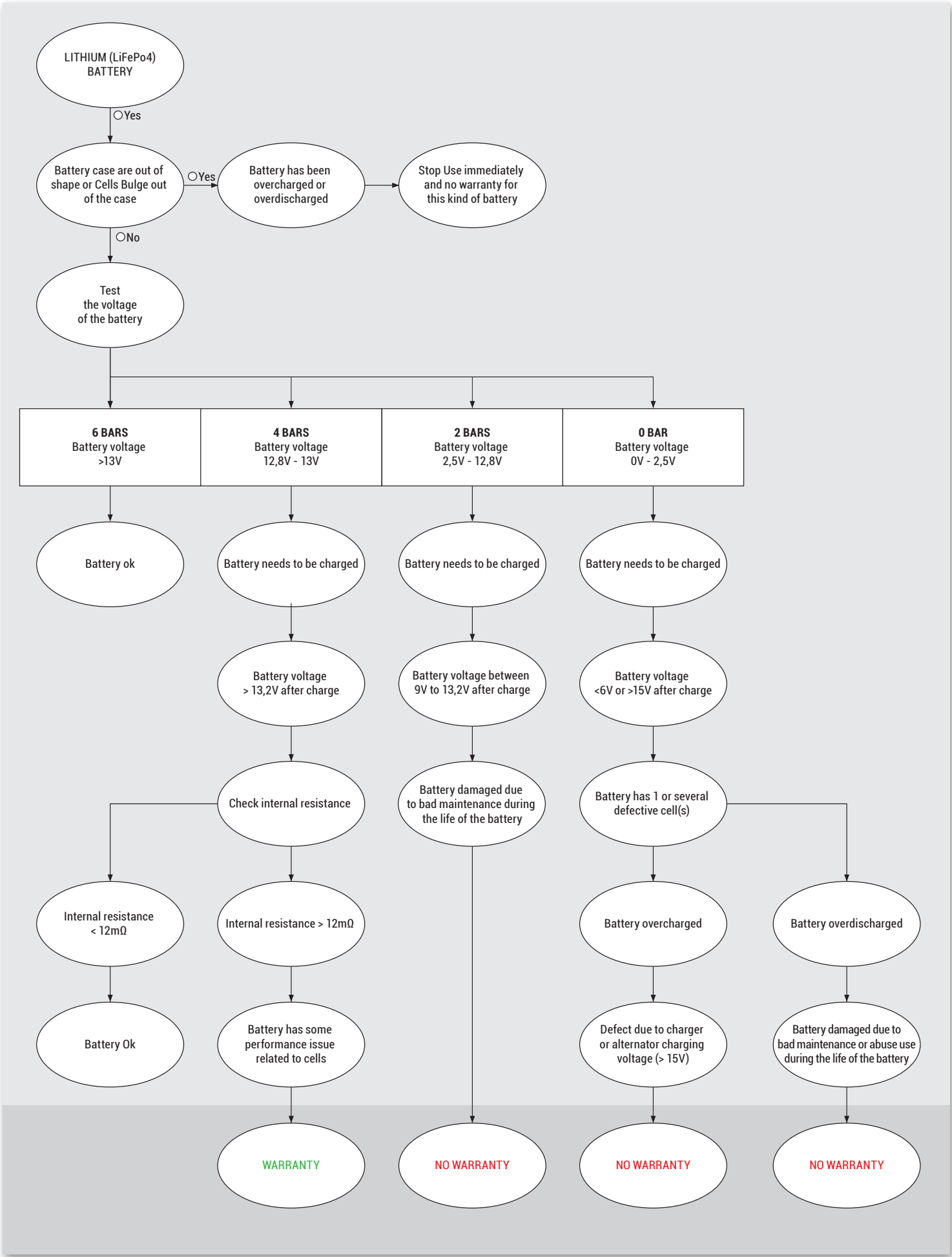
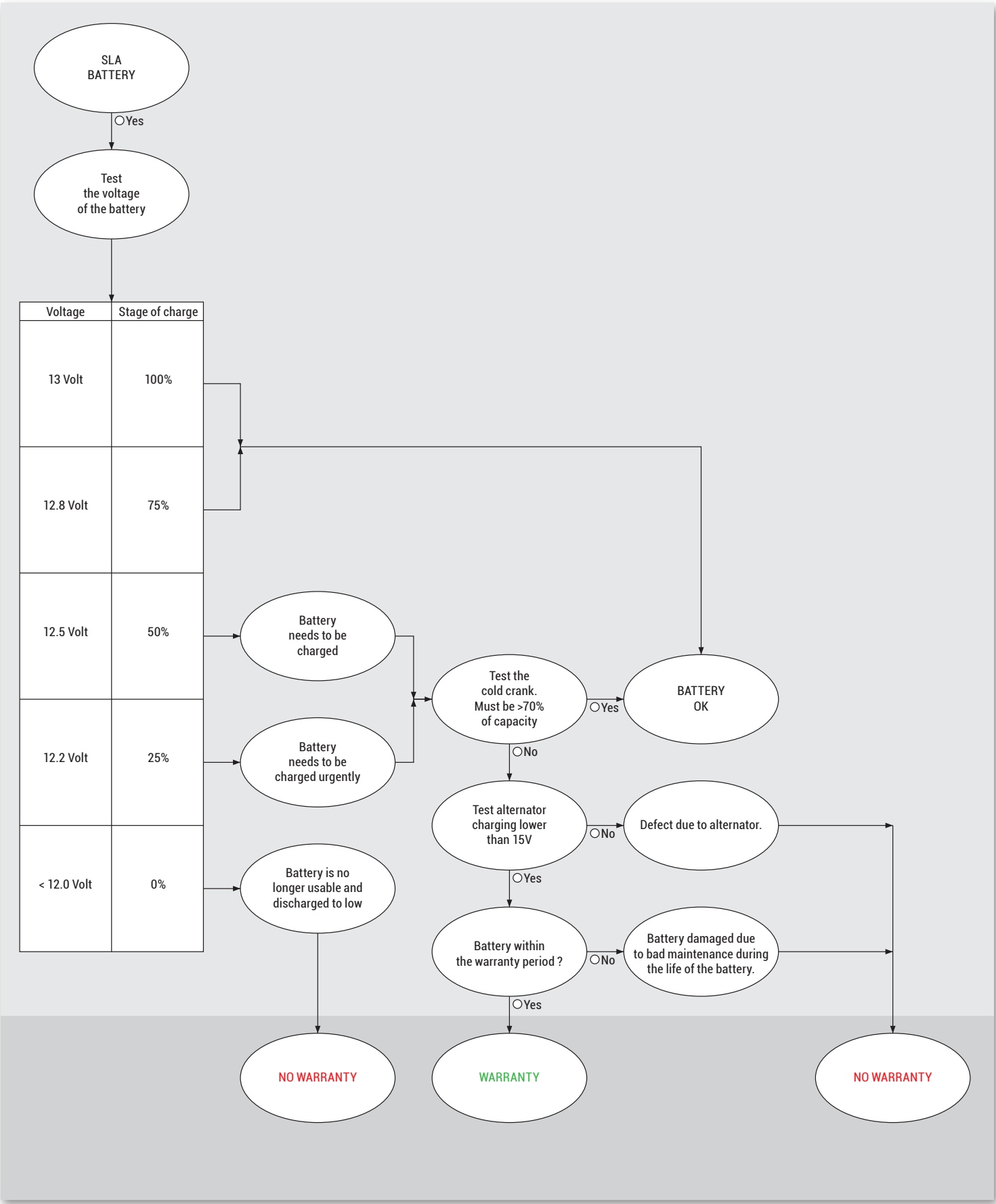
1. When the battery is returned to the sales point within the proposed warranty period.
2. Short circuit in one or more elements if the battery is brand new.
3. Internal interruption or bad terminal connection.
4. Inversed polarity of a new battery.

When is the warranty claim rejected?

1. Excessive runout.
2. Consequences of negligence or improper handling.
3. Case or lid damage.
4. Damaged terminals.
5. Frozen batteries.
6. Use of the battery in the wrong application/vehicle.
7. Use of additives other than recommended.

- 2 second digits correspond to the week of production

- 2 second digits correspond to the week of production
22 = 22th week of the year
